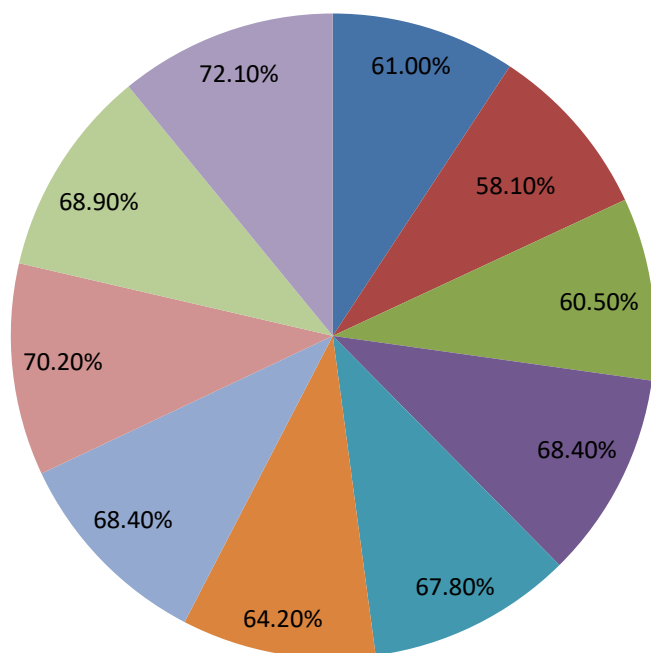

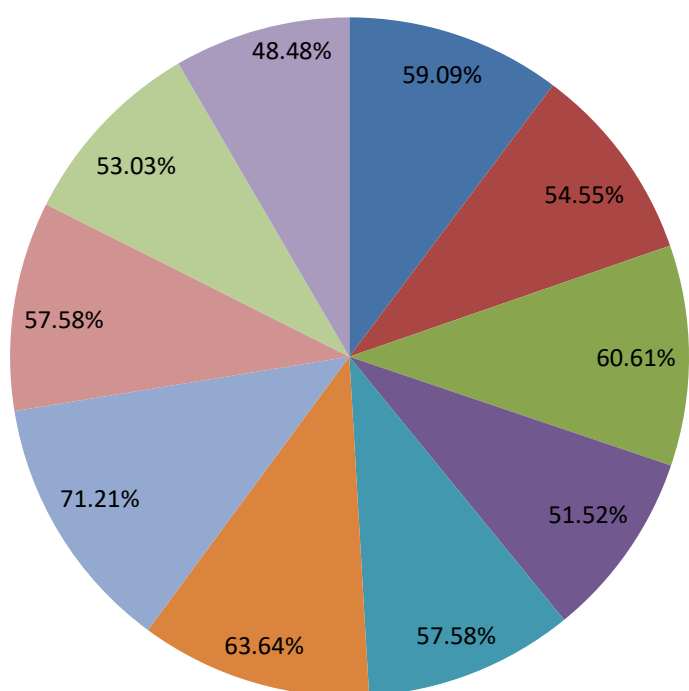

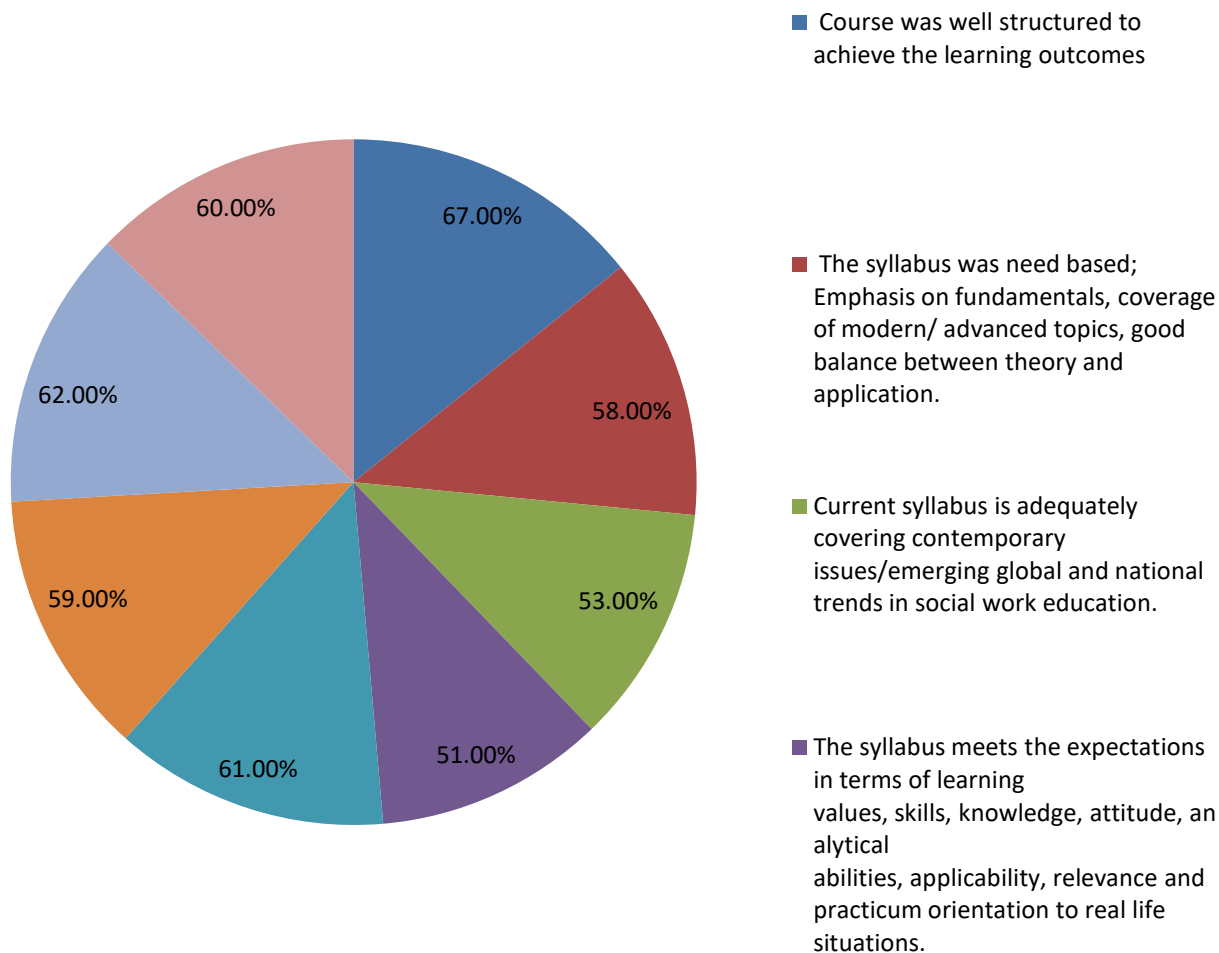

% of responses



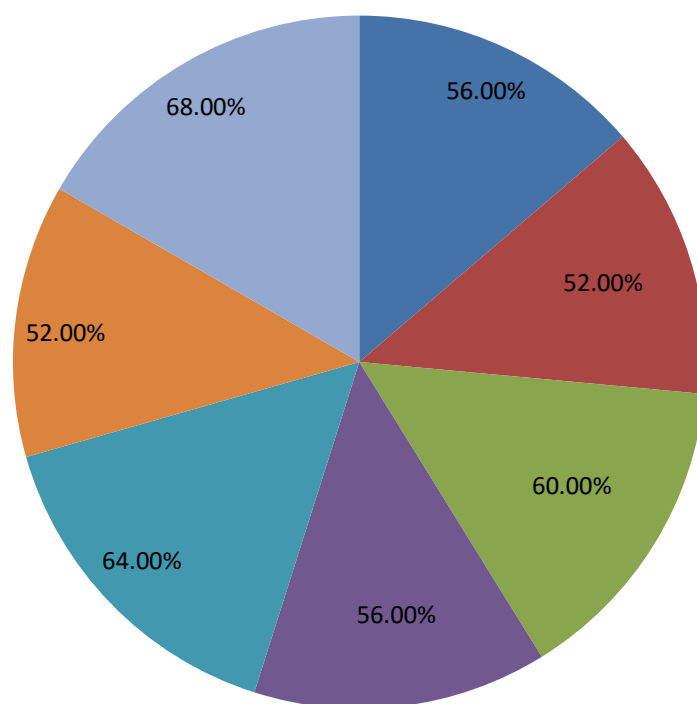
