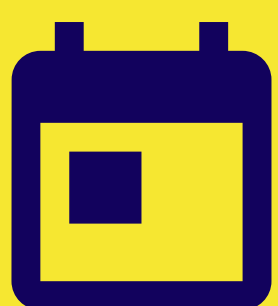

How to Reach

Wardha, a district place is 76Kms from Nagpur. It can be easily reach by roadways & railways. Most of the express trains running on the Howrah-Mumbai & Delhi-Chennai/Kanyakumari stop here.
