It has a special historical significance in terms of Sevagram and Pavanar Ashram. It was here that the seeds of 'Quit India Movement' were sown here. 'Gitai Mandir', "Magan Sangralaya', 'Vishwashanti Stupa' and 'Laxminarayan Mandir' are very popular tourist places in Wardha.

About the E-Coference:

Title: "Role of Sardar Patel in Indian Freedom Movement"

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel (31 October 1875-15 December 1950) is one of prominent leader along with Gandhiji who fought the battle of freedom, won it and contributed to the construction of Modern Independent India. The great achievement of Sardar Patel is, to lead the various Satyagraha movements. He was the most dedicated leader of the Indian National Congress and played a crucial role during the freedom struggle of India..

Sardar Patel led several Satyagraha movements, like Kheda Satyagraha, Borsad Satyagraha, Nagpur Flag Satyagraha and Bardoli Satyagraha. He also participated in several Satyagrahas, like Non cooperative Movement, Civil Disobedience Movement, Quit India Movement, etc. under the leadership of Mahatma Gandhi.

After independence of India, united, independent India was formed with the efforts of this great man. Sardar Patel is credited for achieving political integration of India. Due to the achievement of this great work, he was awarded the title of "The Iron Man of India". As the first Home Minister and Deputy Prime Minister of India, he organized relief for refugees fleeing from Punjab and Delhi and led efforts to restore peace across the nation. For his unique services to the nation, Sardar Patel was conferred with Bharat. Ratna in 1991.

Sardar Patel & Late Bapuraoji Deshmukh, the founder president of Yeshwant Rural Education Socity, participated in the various freedom movements launched by Mahatma Gandhi and spent many years in jail. Mahatma Gandhiji was the source of inspiration for both the great leaders. During the freedom struggle of India, Sardar Patel came several times to Sevagram.
